- Registered participants agree to completely fill the adopted stockings and purchase new gifts for girls and/or boys between the ages of 5-12. Please do not include food items, money, notes and wrapped gifts. - Cover each adopted stocking with the provided topper(s). Please initial or write your team's name on the topper and include child's gender and age. For example: Charlie's Angels – Girl – 5 years old.
- Contact Octavio Serrano once the stockings are stuffed to schedule a date/time to drop-off items. Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
- Upon arrival to The Salvation Army of Orlando's Administration Building (416 West Colonial Drive), a representative will capture a photo and a brief video of the participant(s) with the stockings in hand. Participants are encouraged to say the following on-camera, "My name or group name is [insert name]. I participated in The Salvation Army of Orlando's "Stuff the Stocking Challenge." I challenge [insert name] to participate."
